The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 56 dated 28.2.2016 registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad under Sections 363, 366, 120-B IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in the statement made under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the prosecutrix had made a statement against Ram Niwas and no allegations were attributed to the petitioner and she had also stated that she wanted to live with Gurdeep.
