JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 121, dated July 05, 2015, under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-2**).

2. In compliance of order dated February 19, 2016,

statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jalandhar, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with the intervention of the respectable of the area, without any coercion, pressure and the same appears to be genuine. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 121, dated July 05, 2015, under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
