Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.324 dated 6.6.2015, registered under Sections 20/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sector 7, District Faridabad.

2. Counsel for the parties have been heard.

3. As per prosecution version, secret information had been received on 6.6.2015 that one Anil son of Ajaib Singh and who was driver of commercial vehicle bearing registration No.HR-38Q-9296 and owned by M.A.Transport, Faridabad is being used for smuggling drugs and narcotics. As per secret information, a consignment of drugs has been brought and the vehicle is parked in Sector 11-B, Faridabad. Upon receiving such information, a raiding party was constituted and reached on the spot. At

about 9.00 p.m., a Bolero vehicle bearing registration No.RJ-05UA-3225 reached at the spot and certain packets were being transferred from the commercial vehicle and loaded on to the Bolero vehicle.

4. The present petitioner was apprehended on the spot and from the cabin of the commercial vehicle while transferring consignment to the Bolero vehicle.

5. The alleged recovery is stated to be of 310 kgs. of Ganja.

6. In the light of such alleged heavy and commercial recovery and the petitioner having been apprehended on the spot, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail.

7. Petition is dismissed.
