The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No. 123 dated 11.10.2015, registered under Section 306/34 IPC and subsequently Section 304-B IPC was added. The case has been registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, Distt. Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners, who are Jaith and Jaithani, are in custody since 11.10.2015. He also states that besides the petitioners, husband is also facing trial and the complainant has been examined and no suicide note was left.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, as the conclusion of trial will take time, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
