Present application has been filed on behalf of the applicant/petitioner seeking amendment of the prayer clause of the bail application and adding of Sections 66-C & 66-D of the Information Technology Act, which inadvertently were not mentioned.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Pardeep Kumar, points out that the relief for the offences under Sections 467, IPC as also Sections 66-C & 66-D of the Information Technology Act have not been included.

MAIN CASE

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner-Kuldeep Singh in case FIR No.21 dated 26.02.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Mansa City, District Mansa.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the applicant/petitioner-accused prays for permission to withdraw the present petition to enable his client to file the fresh petition with full particulars.
