Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for directing respondents no.1 to 4 to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners who apprehend danger at the hands of respondents no.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for respondents no.5 and 6 states that the respondents are not giving any threat to the petitioners, as alleged and rather, they accept the marriage, if it has been solemnised by the petitioners.

Mr. Jagdeep Singh, respondent no.7, is present in person.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that since respondents no.5 to 7 are not extending any threat to petitioners, as alleged, the petitioners do not wish to press this petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
