Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Joga Singh @ Joga in case FIR No.17 dated 19.02.2016 for the offences punishable under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered with Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural.

There is a recovery of 1005 loose intoxicating tablets from the possession of the petitioner.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 19.02.2016.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that while making the arrest, there is violation of Section 50 of the NDPS Act.

This thing is a matter of trial and keeping in view the seized quantity, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
