Criminal miscellaneous application i.e. CRM-17790-2016 is allowed. Order dated 21.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) is taken on record.

The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Inspector Lalit Kumar, SHO, Sector 5, Panchkula, alleging that on 23.01.2016, on the basis of secret information regarding involvement of the petitioner and his co-accused in the immoral activities, the police party raided a spot near building of Bella Vista in Panchkula. The petitioner on seeing the police party had signaled all the co-accused to escape from the spot and hit the vehicle of the police party. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused.

State counsel opposed the bail application and on the instructions from Sub Inspector Pawan Kumar also contended that the petitioner is involved in one another case of similar nature.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that the challan has already been presented in the case. Recovery has already been effected. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody during entire period of trial.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate subject to the condition that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activity during pendency of the trial.
