TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case F.I.R. No.77 dated 18.04.2016, under sections 181/420/466/468/471/474/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Brief facts that may be noticed are that one Sukhdev Singh was nominated as an accused in FIR No.9 dated 20.01.2011. Accused, Sukhdev Singh absented himself from the trial proceedings and, as such, notice was issued to the surety, namely, Harpinder Singh. Upon verification having been carried out, it transpired that surety, Harpinder Singh had submitted forged and fabricated documents to the Court to facilitate the grant of benefit of bail to accused, Sukhdev Singh. Precise accusation against the present petitioner is that he had identified surety, Harpinder Singh who stood as a surety for accused, Sukhdev Singh.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious. Matter would require a deep and thorough probe and which may also entail custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Prayer made in the present petition seeking concession of anticipatory bail is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
