This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.303 dated 17.12.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at P.S. NIT Faridabad.

On 26.05.2016 the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Assistant Manager of State Bank of India, Faridabad.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, allegation against him is that he is the person who had actually supplied cheque to the husband of Suman for misappropriating the amount.

Notice to the Advocate General, Haryana for

20.07.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on 11.06.2016, 18.06.2016 and 02.07.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from S.I. Lachman Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 26.05.2016 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
