INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent Nos.4 to 7, who are parents, paternal uncle and maternal uncle of petitioner No.2. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. The copy of birth certificate (Annexure P-1) of petitioner No.1, copy of 'Adhar' card (Annexure P-2) of petitioner No.2 and photographs (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners have been placed on record.

Heard.

The respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, is directed to look into the representation dated 24.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) and if he/she satisfies that there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners then shall take necessary steps, as per law, to protect their life and liberty.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
