The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 179 dated 08.11.2014 registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur under Sections 406/498-A/313 IPC.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.05.2015, the petitioners had joined the investigation and they were declared innocent in the investigation but the complainant had moved an application and it is being examined. He further states that their custodial interrogation is not required.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 27.05.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
