1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that he has been summoned by the trial court in a complaint titled as “Paramjit Singh vs Jasbir Singh and others” under Sections 427 and 506 IPC. It is stated that the petitioners are N.R.I. Now, the lower court has started the proceedings to declare them proclaimed offenders.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that they do not challenge the summoning order and will appear before the lower court within two months, considering that intervening there are summer vacation. In the meanwhile, the petitioners may not be declared proclaimed offenders.

In view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that if the petitioner appear before the lower court within two months from today, they should not be declared proclaimed offender and for the said period of two months, the proceedings to declare the petitioners as proclaimed offenders shall remain stayed.
