FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 11.05.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Surjit Singh and Baljinder Kaur as well as of complainant Jugraj Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a small dispute over movable articles and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.05 dated 09.02.2015 under Sections 403,406,380,506,34 IPC Police Station, NRI, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings

arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
