JASPAL SINGH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.184, dated 06.08.2008, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Banga, District Nawanshahr (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of mutual compromise dated 04.01.2016.

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that matter has been compromised between the parties with their own sweet will. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been

amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances and in view of the pronouncement captioned as **Kulwinder Singh & others v. State of Punjab & others**; 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.184, dated 06.08.2008, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Banga, District Nawanshahr and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
