Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No76 dated 28.4.2016 under Section 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act registered at Police Station I.T. Park, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 8.8.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that the dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved.

The aforesaid facts have not been disputed either by learned APP or by learned counsel for the complainant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide orders dated 2.6.2016 and 8.8.2016 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
