The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.234 dated 26.12.2013 under sections 382, 511, 34 I.P.C and section 22 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, City Moga.

During the course of arguments, it stands conceded by the counsel that the alleged recovery effected was commercial in nature. Report of the Chemical Examiner has already been received and even the challan stands presented.

It may also be noticed that the petitioners had been granted the concession of interim bail but have misused the same inasmuch as they have not appeared before the Trial Court.

In view of the above, prayer made in the present petition is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
