Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner- Suresh Kumar @ Bunty in case FIR No.21 dated 26.02.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66-D of the Information Technology Act, registered with Police Station Mansa City, District Mansa.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Pardeep Kumar, points out that the prayer clause does not contain the added offences i.e. Section 467, IPC, as also Section 66-C of the Information Technology Act.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner-accused prays for permission to withdraw the present petition to enable his client to file the fresh petition with full particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
