Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 170 dated 11.12.2013 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Rajaund, District Kaithal on the basis of compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of Shamsher Singh, complainant on the allegations that the petitioners duped the complainant for a sum of Rs, 64,280/- taken from him by enticing him with a false insurance that he will be given loan on Mark Sheet.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe by this Court that parties appeared before the Illaqa Magistrate and got their statements recorded. As per the report received, the matter has been amicably settled.

In view of the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **“Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) Recent Criminal Reports (P&H), 1052”**, I am of the opinion that on account of the matter

having been amicably resolved between the parties, neither any useful purpose will be served nor any fruitful result by trial would be achieved.

The petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR all the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
