Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. In FIR No.53 dated 28.7.2015, under Sections 353/186 IPC and Section 68-B of the Punjab Police Act, 2007, registered at Police Station Airport, District Amritsar City, the petitioner is being prosecuted. Respondent No.3, Superintendent of Customs is appearing with his Counsel Shri Amandeep Singh. Shri Amandeep Singh, counsel for respondent No.3 as well as respondent No.3, both say that the petitioner has apologized to respondent No.3 and therefore, respondent No.3 does not want to proceed further in the matter. In my view, looking to the compromise that has been arrived at, there is no point in continuing with the prosecution. In the result, petition is allowed and the FIR in question, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compromise.
