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**JASPAL SINGH, J**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") read with Sections 340 and 195 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the official respondents to conduct an enquiry in a fair and impartial manner qua respondent No.4 for submitting a false affidavit in CRM-M-28-2016 decided on January 05, 2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner while placing reliance upon date of birth certificate (Annexure P-1) has submitted that in fact the date of birth of Paramjeet Kaur-petitioner No.1 (in CRM-M-28-2016) is October 18, 1998 and she is less than 18 years of age, at the time of filing of protection petition. However, by way of filing affidavit just to secure the favourable order has shown herself to be 18.10.1996.
3. Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.
4. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts

notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of by allowing the petitioner to move representation before respondent No.2 unfolding all the facts and pleas taken in this petition, within a week, who shall decide the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the representation, in accordance with law.
