Petitioners are ladies who, being members of unlawful assembly, are alleged to be responsible for the murder of Mewa Singh who was pushed by Gurdeep Singh and died on account of fall on the cot.

The main allegations are against Gurdeep Singh. All the petitioners have joined investigation as per the instructions of SI Nazir Singh. The culpability of the petitioner apparently is a debatable issue on the basis of the allegations of complainant-Randhir Singh.

It does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation. Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer subject to conditions that: (i) the petitioners will join investigation as and when

required; (ii) they will not tamper with the investigation in any manner and
(iii) they will not directly or indirectly make any inducement to the
witnesses.
