AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34 dated 10.04.2015, registered under Sections 306/34 IPC, at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner accompanied the main accused, who was threatening the deceased to expose his mis-deeds and as a result of that pressure the deceased committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has

been in custody since 21.03.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Emmanuel Mall has accepted this factual assertion.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
