This writ petition was filed by the petitioner against Haryana Vidut Parsaran Nigam Ltd. in July 2000 with a primary prayer *“for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularly maintain and upgrade the electricity over-head current wires with proper earthing laid down by the respondents in the fields of village Ballah where petitioner resides.”*

No written statement was filed and the writ petition was admitted on February 28, 2001. On 9.4.2016 and 6.5.2016 petitioner had appeared in person. On the last date of hearing we had passed the following order:

*“Mr. Dharampal, SDO prays for time to file affidavit of a responsible officer as to what is the position of the overhead wires allegedly passing through the fields of the petitioner. In other words, that the wires are not loose, there is no sparking, the connections are proper as also the earthing.*

*Adjourned to 19.7.2016.*

*Copy of the order be given to Mr. Dharampal, SDO.”*

Today Mr. Dharam Pal, SDO has filed an affidavit dated

13.7.2016 which reads as under:

**“Affidavit**

*I, Dharam Pal SDO s/o Sh. Ram Singh working as SDO at SDO 'OP' S/Divn. UHBVN, Munak, Tehsil Gharaunda District Karnal solemnly affirm and declare as under:*

- 1. I am working as sub divisional officer (SDO) under UHBVN.*
- 2. That I have personally checked the electrical line crossing over the field of Sh. Jagdish Chander s/o Sh. Jai Narain r/o Village Ballah as per direction of Hon'ble High Court in Daily Lok Adalat Bench No.1 bearing CWP No. 7953 of 2000.*
- 3. That, I have found that no any wire has been loose nor any sparking in the wire.*
- 4. That, I have checked the field and found earthling work has properly been done.*
- 5. That the deponent has been abiding by all rules and regulations made by UHBVN from time to time.*

According to us, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be consigned to record-room with liberty to the petitioner to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
