The prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Balwinder Singh in case FIR No.468 dated 05.09.2006, under Sections 279, 337, 338, 304-A, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda.

The petitioner was enlarged on bail and for his absence on 31.01.2012, he was declared proclaimed offender on 31.07.2012. He was subsequently arrested on 15.03.2016.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Babaljeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has delayed the trial for almost four years and is not entitled to the concession of bail.

Keeping in view the previous conduct of the petitioner, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
