This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.43 dated 25.01.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Jhajjar.

It has been stated that the matter has been settled between the parties. It is not disputed that out of sum of Rs. 13,50,000/- which was transferred in the name of the petitioner, the police had been able to recover Rs. 10, 75,000/-. This amount be released to the complainant. The IO is

directed to disburse the amount to the complainant immediately.

The petitioner be released on interim bail, within 1 month of the released thereof the petitioner will deposit the remaining amount Rs. 2, 75,000/- in the Court of CJM, Jhajjar as stated by his counsel.

Bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar

Once the entire amount is disbursed, the petitioner is at liberty to file a case to quash the FIR on the basis of today's settlement. The receipt given by the complainant would be deem it to be his consent to the said quashing.

It is made clear that in case the amount is not paid within one month , the interim bail would be liable to be cancelled.

Petition stands disposed of in the above said terms.
