This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to further direct respondent No.3 to conduct investigation in fair manner in case FIR No. 34, dated 05.02.2015, under Sections 279, 337 and 304-A IPC, Police Station Chandimandir, Panchkula and to arrest the actual culprit.

2. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that though a representation has been made to Commissioner of Police as well as the Chief Minister of Haryana on 06.10.2015 but no action has been taken by either of the authorities so far.

3 But perusal of file transpires that no such copy of any representation has been appended.

4. Notice to respondent-State.

5. On the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to petitioner to move a fresh representation to the Commissioner of Police detailing all the facts, which shall be considered and dealt with by the Commissioner of Police within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order, and if some substance is found in the representation, to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
