Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Though the documents attached with the petition show that some civil litigation is pending between the parties and, therefore, it can be presumed that it is in that background, the present petition has been filed. However, taking into consideration the allegations made by the petitioners in complaint/representation dated 19.5.2016 (Annexure P-4) and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to look into the contents of said representation and to take appropriate action in accordance with law expeditiously.
