Amended Memo of Parties filed in Court today, is taken on record.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that on 24.5.2016, they had performed marriage against the wishes of their parents. The certificate of the marriage has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The true typed copies of Secondary Examination Certificate and Aadhar Card, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 24.5.2016 (Annexure-P-5) before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

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In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali-respondent No. 9, to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
