Petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly had allegedly obstructed the entry of police in Satlok Ashram of Baba Rampal. He is alleged to have pelted stones and petrol bombs and prevented the police party to enter. Injuries were caused to the police officials.

With the assistance of State counsel and ASI Satbir Singh, I have gone through the record. The material evidence which has been gathered against the petitioner, is in the nature of extra judicial confession of the petitioner and his accomplice, admissibility of which evidence would certainly be a debatable issue during the course of trial.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been operated for brain cancer, he can be granted the concession of bail as similarly circumstanced co-accused have been granted the same

relief. On the basis of the said operation, he has been transferred to Rohtak jail for proper treatment.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
