Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that the entire prosecution witnesses have been examined and the case is fixed for defence evidence. It will not be appropriate for this Court at this stage to enter into the niceties of the trial to determine the *prima facie* culpability of the petitioner for the purpose of grant or refusal of bail, lest it should prejudice the right of the prosecution or the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed, with a direction to the trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the trial by giving short dates of hearing.
