In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has questioned the order of dismissal dated 31.08.1991(Annexure P-14) and the award of the Labour Court dated 31.07.1996 (Annexure P-15). On certain allegations petitioner and one Mr. Krishan Kumar Malik were charge sheeted. In the disciplinary proceedings both of them have been dismissed from service. Both of them have approached Labour Court and Award of the Labour Court was against them. Mr. Krishan Kumar Malik filed CWP No.3601 of 1999 which were decided on 17.3.1999 while upholding the order of
