JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jagsir Singh in case FIR No.130 dated 16.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 188 and 283 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Dyalpura, District Bathinda.

As per the allegations residents of village Dyalpura had raised a blockade of main highway and also pelted stones/brickbats and police officials trying to clear the blockade received injuries while trying to maintain law and order.

It is contended that neither the petitioner is a resident of

Dyalpura nor was named in the FIR nor anybody has said that he was present at the site.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Surjit Singh submits that the name of the petitioner specifically finds mention with the name of village in the FIR itself and his role is that of pelting stones at the police party causing injuries to them while removing the blockade undertaken by the mob.

Keeping in view the gravity of offence in the light of the impact on the society, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
