Petitioner was allegedly found in possession of 350 gram of Charas with physical property of green colour alleged to be Sulfa. Report of the chemical examiner has not yet been received, as per the information supplied by ASI Ram Niwas, to the State counsel. Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 15.02.2016.

In the above circumstances, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim temporary bail, till the receipt of the report of the chemical examiner, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Sonapat.

It is made clear that the petitioner will be required to surrender before the Special Judge concerned, on receipt of the report of the chemical examiner, without prejudice to his right to seek concession of regular bail, in accordance with law, depending upon the circumstances, existed at that stage.
