This second petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for granting of interim bail for 15 days to attend the marriage of real sister of the petitioner on 31.01.2016.

Custody certificate has been filed in the Court, is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the marriage of the real sister namely Beant Kaur, is slated for 31.01.2016, which is duly admitted by the learned State counsel.

The learned State counsel states that the petitioner is involved

in other two FIRs and opposed the relief sought by the petitioner.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the marriage of the real sister of the petitioner is fixed for 31.01.2016 and as per customs, he has to perform the rites and rituals, it is ordered that the petitioner will be taken to the venue of the marriage on the date fixed under the Police Protection. Accordingly, the authorities are directed to make the necessary arrangement for implementation of the order and all the expenses for the said purpose will be borne by the petitioner.

The petitioner shall be lodged in the jail on the same day at 5.30 PM.
