HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition seeking regular bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.145 dated 12.04.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Branch Manager, UCO Bank, Sankhol on the allegation that on 14.10.2014, a fictitious account was got opened in the name of Sunil son of Mahabir Singh on the basis of fake documents.

Status report has been filed on behalf of the State in which it has been stated that during investigation, accused Neeraj Kumar @ Moni son of Satbir Singh resident of Village Asaudha Siwan, District Jhajjar was arrested on 14.04.2016. During investigation, it was found that Neeraj Kumar @ Moni impersonated himself as Sunil son of Mahabir and by using a fake name in fake document, he opened two accounts one account in UCO Bank, Sankhol and another account in Central Bank of India, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar

and by operating these two accounts, embezzled Rs.36,43,774/-. He also named the petitioner, Subhash Kumar and Kaptan as being involved in the alleged forgery.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 16.04.2016. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. Barring the statement of accused Neeraj Kumar during investigation, there is nothing against the petitioner. Even Neeraj Kumar has not attributed any specific act to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petition is allowed.

Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
