Mr. N.S. Shekhawat, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is being tried under Sections 420, 34 IPC in respect of FIR No.389 dated 30.10.2014 registered at Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda. He is incarcerated since one year and six months. He further submits that out of 13 witnesses, only two witnesses have been examined.

This fact is not denied by the learned State Counsel.

In view of the fact that the trial may take some more time, in the interest of justice, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

Criminal Petition stands allowed.
