The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.17 dated 27.02.2015, under Sections 472/473 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 21/27-A/29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar City.

Petitioner was arrested on 27.02.2015 and as per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from him is of 01 Kg heroin and 2 lac Indian currency notes.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Santokh Singh against whom also there was an alleged recovery of 01 Kg heroin and 3 lac Indian currency notes has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 16.05.2016 passed in CRM No.M-44339 of 2015.

On the ground of parity as also for the same very reasons as recorded in the order dated 16.05.2016 passed in CRM No.M-44339 of

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2015, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
