Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.0003 dated 29.01.2016, registered at Women Police Station, Panipat, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 323/376(2)(n)/506/34 IPC.

As per contents of the FIR, the complainant is about 35 years of age and the petitioner is a young boy of 23 years and there is a difference of more than eleven years between them. After registration of the FIR, challan was presented and charges were framed in this case. Out of fourteen witnesses, four have been examined which includes the complainant as well. The allegations in the FIR are that on the pretext of marriage, the petitioner had committed rape for two years with the complainant. The trial is not likely to conclude.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2016.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during the pendency of the trial of the present case, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.
