This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0066 dated

59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

On 28.05.2016 the following order was passed:-

“Heard.

Notice of motion, returnable for 08.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Raj has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 28.05.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
