Petitioners seek concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of secret information that country made liquor was recovered from co-accused Jassi who was carrying the illegal liquor in his truck.

The petitioners were involved in the case, on the basis of statement of co-accused, to the effect that the material had been loaded by the petitioners and that they had prepared the forged documents. Recoveries of laptop, bilty bill, printer and vehicle have already been effected.

The petitioners have been in custody w.e.f. 08.04.2016. A perusal of the police file indicates that it is a debatable issue whether the guilt of the petitioners could be proved on the mere statement of co-accused as till date, corroborative material has not been gathered.

Without expression of any opinion, the petitioners are ordered to be

released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqua Magistrate subject to the condition that in case the petitioners are found indulging in similar activity, this bail order will be liable to be cancelled.
