Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Ravi Gupta alleging that on 15.10.2015, he along with his brother Raju were intercepted by unidentified persons who gave beatings to them and forcibly snatched their Activa Scooter and escaped. The petitioner was involved in the present case under Section 379-B, 341 and 411 IPC, on the basis of his confessional statement made by him while in custody on 13.2.2016

Petitioner was also arrested in another case under the NDPS Act registered vide FIR No.10 of 26.1.2014 on 13.2.2016, on the basis of his confessional statement.

Without expression of any opinion on merits or involvement of petitioner in other cases, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has been connected with the present case FIR No.130 of 16.10.2015, under Section 379-B, 341 and 411 IPC on the basis of his confessional statement made while in custody in another case.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Ilaqua Magistrate .
