ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

1. The petitioner seeks transfer of investigation to some Senior Officials. The allegations are that the local police has colluded with respondent no.7 and is not taking action on the FIR registered on 26.04.2016.

2. The petitioner is a widow. Her husband has died about 16 years ago. She was living in a rented accommodation owned by respondent no.7. The allegations levelled by the petitioner were that respondent no.7 lured her and promised marriage and had physical relation with her and gave false assurances of marriage but later on refused to marry her. The applicant gave an application to the police but no action was taken. She then approached the Women Police Station at Panipat. The allegations are that the police was not arresting respondent no.7. Allegations were also made that respondent nos.5 & 6 were pressurizing her to compromise the matter, which she had

refused. She seeks transfer of the investigation to some other agency.

3. The police has lodged a FIR. A representation has been given by the petitioner to the senior officials. No directions are required to be given nor it is a case which should be transferred.

The petition is dismissed.
