This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.923 dated 09.09.2015, registered under Section 419, 420 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar, Haryana.

On 28.05.2016 the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner is alleged to have appeared through an impersonator in the STET/HTET examination which has been detected on the basis of the difference in the thumb impression on OMR sheet.

Notice to Advocate General, Haryana, for August 9,

2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on or before June 10, 2016 and in case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from the investigating officer has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 28.05.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
