Report dated 05.07.2016 sent by learned Civil Judge, (Junior Division)-Cum-Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Jeevan Jyoti @ Jyoti and Rajiv as well as of complainants Gurpreet Singh Konsal and Charan Singhit has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure money dispute and the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and**

another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543 and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.23 dated 07.05.2014 under Sections 406,420 IPC Police Station, Division No.6, Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
