The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.61, dated 4.4.2016, registered under Sections 379-B and (411/34 added lateron) of the IPC, at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot; this is a case of Magisterial trial, and that he has now been in custody since 5.4.2016.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from SI Sita Ram,

has accepted this factual assertion but states that two stolen mobile phones have been recovered from the petitioner.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
