By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.17, dated 15.02.2016, registered under Section 406 IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala.

It is contended that petitioner is mother in-law of complainant, Rupinder Kaur. Both have lost their husbands in a motor vehicular accident. The widowed daughter in-law alleges that petitioner is not returning her gold ornaments and 2.60 lacs in cash. All the articles were returned and even otherwise the petitioner is ready for an amicable settlement with the complainant. In pursuance of the order dated 30.05.2016, the petitioner has joined the

investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.05.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
