FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Randhir Singh in case FIR No.3 dated 15.03.2016 registered at Police Station NRI, District Amritsar under Sections 419/420/465/467/471/120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 28.05.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Prabh Dayal, Police Station NRI Amritsar who submits that the petitioner is no longer

required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.05.2016 is made absolute, however he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
