TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.555 dated 28.12.2015, under Sections 148/307/506/120-B/216/325/149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Saroj Devi in relation to an occurrence that took place on the intervening night of 27/28.12.2015. Injured in this case is Shamsher Singh i.e. husband of the complainant.

Shamsher Singh is stated to have suffered a fire arm injury on the left side of the chest which has attracted offence under Section 307 IPC.

As per complainant's version herself, such gun shot injury is attributed to co-accused, Vipin.

Even though the present petitioner was stated to be armed and present at the occurrence but no specific gun shot injury is attributed to him

and on the person of the injured-Shamsher Singh.

Petitioner was arrested on 01.01.2016.

Investigation in the case having been completed, challan presented on 29.03.2016.

The trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on the merits, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.

Disposed of.
