Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Daljeet Singh states that the entire prosecution evidence has been concluded. This fact has been denied by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

At this stage, I am not inclined to disbelieve the statement made by the prosecuting agency and dismiss the petition. However, the trial

Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction if the statement is incorrect.
